**Supermicro** launched its dual-processor SuperWorkstation 7045A-WT, designed to handle high-end computing tasks while producing a minimal amount of excess system noise. The SuperWorkstation 7045A-WT generates just 28dB of sound, making it a logical addition to Supermicro's Whisper-Quiet product line. Based on the Intel 5400 (Seaburg) chipset, the workstation supports a 1,600MHz FSB, 1.5-volt 800MHz FB-DIMM memory, two x16 PCI Express 2.0 slots, and a user's choice of Intel's quad-core Xeon 5400 or dual-core 5200 series processors. Other features include an 865-watt power supply; up to 6TB of SATA capacity; and the ability to upgrade to dual-port 10 Gigabit Ethernet, 4-port Gigabit Ethernet, InfiniBand, or internal and external SAS.
